NOTIFICATION OF RELEASE

The Rhode Island State Police is releasing the following information pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws § 11-37.1-1 et seq, also known as the Sexual Offender Registration and Community Notification Act. This individual is subject to community notification of his pending release or relocation pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws § 11-37.1-12 of the Act, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release from prison or residential relocation when the Sex Offender Board of Review determines that the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual listed below has been convicted of a sex offense and requires registration with law enforcement pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws § 11-37.1-1 et seq. **This offender is not wanted by the police at this time and has served the sentence imposed on him by the court. This notification is not to increase fear in the community. It is the belief of law enforcement that an informed public is a safe public. Abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered offenders will not be tolerated and is a crime.**
